



Play Group is a script development group run by Robin Hood Theatre as part of our commitment to encourage new writing in the East Midlands region.

The Group meets on a monthly basis at the theatre from 7pm to 9pm.

Group members are invited to bring along enough a short scene from a script they are developing – about 6 pages of A4- with a copy for each character. The member submitting will be asked to cast the scene from the members present, who will perform an unrehearsed reading.

The whole group can give feedback on the script, followed by general discussion during which the writer can ask questions and request advice.

Actor members are welcome to attend to read and comment, as are writers who have no new work to bring.

The intention is to help members develop scripts that are suitable to send to theatres running script submissions windows and competitions. Information about these opportunities will be shared with the group as they arise. Members will be encouraged to submit their work and share any successes with the group.

Robin Hood's new script submission window will be open during September 2018. Three plays will be selected from this for a partial rehearsed reading at the theatre in 2019. If the board feels that one of these plays shows sufficient merit, it will be included in our 2019-20 season for a three night run in our New Works slot.
